Prevent is one part of the government's overall counter-terrorism strategy, CONTEST. The aim of Prevent is to:

- tackle the ideological causes of terrorism
- intervene early to support people susceptible to radicalisation
- enable those who have already engaged in terrorism to disengage & rehabilitate

- What is Prevent Duty and overview of UK's counter terrorism strategy in respect of Education Sector
- What are the statutory requirements on schools to comply with Prevent Duty
- Overview of current risk and threat picture for Halton and Merseyside (Counter Terrorism Local Profile),
- Prevent Risk Assessment for schools – support with carrying out comprehensive risk assessment utilising DfE's Prevent Risk Assessment tool
- What are schools' responsibilities under the Duty and what actions need to be taken in Education Sector to build resilience to radicalisation.

Though this session is initially for DSLs, Headteachers & Chair of Governors on Prevent and the support available, PREVENT has a multi-agency approach & so therefore this session is also open to other professionals working with Children in Halton.
